

## The Qualifier Series by Byte Enterprises – Interface:

For your ONE TIME ONLY import setup, simply follow these easy steps:

- In DocMagic
  1. From the DocMagic toolbar select the “Setup” menu and click on “Select ASCII Import/Export.”
  2. The “Import Definition to use” is “BYTE.” Click on the drop arrow and select it from the current list.
  3. In the “Directory to Import files from” field, click on the open folder button to locate the specified directory your BYTE borrower files will be exported to. (i.e. C:\DSI\DM)
  4. Click on “Save.”
  5. From the DocMagic toolbar select “Utilities.” Now, select “DOS prompt.” At the DOS prompt, (i.e. C:\DSI\DM). Type in the following command, “edit ..\dm.bat” then enter. Then type in the following commands...

```
C: (or whatever drive letter DocMagic is installed in)
CD\DSI\DMW
CALL DMW.BAT
```
  6. Now to exit “Alt+F,” “X” (to exit), “Y” (to save).
  7. Type in “exit.”

### Steps to export out of The Qualifier Series:

1. Launch The Qualifier Series, and open up the desired borrower file
2. Click on the “Communications” button; click on “Closing Documents;” choose “Select Interface;” select “Show all Providers.”
3. From the available Document Services, double click “DOC Magic”
4. Click on “Create File” (If this is your first time doing this you’ll have to “Browse” to the dm.bat file you created above.)
5. The DocMagic tool bar will automatically launch, allowing you to begin the import into DocMagic

### Steps to import into DocMagic:

1. Click on the “Worksheet” menu and select “Enter Worksheet.”
2. Click on the “File” menu and select “Import.” You will be prompted to “Import new loans now?” Click on “Yes.” Choose the proper file then click on “OK.”

### Tips for the Qualifier Series program:

To find the file TQSPLUS.INI, go to Start, Find, Files or Folders, and in Named type in TQSPLUS.INI and for Look in choose your C:., click on “Find Now.”

In the example we use C:\DSI, the C: is the drive your systems looks at for the DSI folder. The entire example should look like this:

```
[Communications]
DocMagicDirectory=c:\dsi
```

Note: Import instructions only support the current version of this LOS system.
